<p>2009 <b>Graham's LBV Port</b> Elegant aromas of red fruit and eucalyptus, combined with freshly picked mint. On the palate, rich red fruit flavours balanced by taut, peppery tannins.</p>	<p>Douro, Portugal</p> <p>£20.00</p>
